This Otago Fish & Game Council walk is mainly board-walked. It follows the Bullock Creek Stream linking Stone St to the Alpha Series Subdivision. It is fed by several tinkling, wee springs meandering off the slope above the walkway. In time, this will be a fantastic urban sanctuary, providing habitat for fish, birds and other native species and is likely to be very well frequented.
