A 10-minute (return) walk that leads to a concrete structure where a 5" U.S. Naval Gun was housed which provided a clear firing range of the Grey River mouth. Once at the top, you get great views of the Grey River Mouth and parts of Cobden.

This is not considered suitable for Wheelchairs or Prams due to walkers having to negotiate quite a number of steep steps that lead up to the Gun Emplacement. A reasonable level of fitness is recommended however, is achievable for the not so fit if plenty of rest breaks are taken throughout the journey.
